

Introduction


Established in 2007, Higher Vocational College Ravne is a key component of the School Centre Ravne, which also includes the Middle School and Gymnasium. The Intercompany Training Centre is an integral part of this educational hub.

We have two study programmes:

- Mechanical Engineering and
- Mechatronics Engineering.



Our Higher Vocational College operates under the direct jurisdiction of the Ministry of Education. The Higher Vocational College boasts an International Coordinator within its team of 23 lecturers, a Head Teacher, and a Student Affairs Officer. This International Coordinator plays a pivotal role in providing administrative support and facilitating practical arrangements to ensure smooth mobility for incoming and outgoing academic and professional staff, as well as all students.

Upon acceptance, incoming students and staff will receive a comprehensive welcome email, detailing all necessary information prior to their arrival. We offer assistance in finding and confirming accommodation and, if needed, provide travel pick-up services. Each incoming student is paired with a mentor and a tutor student to guide them through their study or training activities and assist with social integration.

The International Coordinator and Head Teacher collaborate to oversee the welcome and support activities for incoming staff. Upon arrival, a warm reception awaits them from the International Coordinator, Head Teacher, and the Director. An organized tour of the higher vocational college, city, and a welcome party further enhances their introduction to our community.

Incoming students coming for study enjoy the same level of care as our current students. In cases of language barriers, lecturers organize additional consultations.

Students are invited to participate in all college activities, including those organized by the Students' Council and the regional students' association. Moreover, a short Slovenian Language Course is offered to facilitate their integration.
